Distinguished Guest Speaker – Tom Tatum

Tom Tatum has served as the outdoors columnist and editor for West Chester's Daily Local News for over 32 years. His column generally appears on Tuesday each week. Now, as the outdoors columnist for Digital First Media, his column appears in multiple newspapers throughout the Delaware Valley including the Pottstown Mercury and a number of weeklies. Tatum also serves as a bowhunting columnist for the *Pennsylvania Game News* and his work has appeared in selected national magazines as well. Tatum's columns and articles have won writing awards on the state, regional, and national stages. These include First Place Sports Column for Excellence in Journalism in 2010 from the Society of Professional Journalists, the 2012 and 2018 Pinnacle Awards from the Professional Outdoor Media Association for best magazine article on the outdoors, and the Outdoor Writers of America Association's first place awards for best fishing article in both 2012 and 2015. Tatum has also served as President of the Pennsylvania Outdoor Writers (2009-2011) Association and President of the Mason-Dixon Outdoor Writers Association (2014-2015).

When not at his desk working on his next column, Tatum spends many hours each summer on the back bays of Ocean City, Maryland, drifting for summer flounder. His entertaining and informative presentation, "Floundering Around with Tom Tatum," features dozens of colorful PowerPoint slides and is based on almost fifty years of fluke fishing experience. This presentation has been well received at fishing expos including the Greater Philadelphia Sports Show. Flounder around with Tatum on his boat, Open Debate, learn the secrets of flounder fishing success, and discover that every time you catch a flounder, it doesn't have to be a fluke.
